PARTNERS OF FAST PROJECT MEET FOR THEIR 2ND TRANSNATIONAL MEETING

The partners of the project FAST (Facilitating Accessibility in Support of Tourism) had their 2nd transnational meeting in the city of Porto in Portugal, hosted by SPI (Sociedade Portuguesa de Inovação). The meeting was held on the 7th and 8th of September 2021, at the facilities of the hosting organization SPI.

Following the previous meeting which was held in Maribor in July, the partners from Slovenia, Austria, Cyprus, Portugal, and Greece discussed the 2nd reporting period of the project. They clarified and finalized the first intellectual output about the job description of the Accessible Travel Facilitator – ATF. Furthermore, the partners presented the dissemination activities which took place during this period, as well as the quality assurance report.

The next meeting will be organized in Vienna, on the 2nd and 3rd of December 2021, by the Austrian partner BEST. The aim of the meeting is to finalize the second intellectual output, which focuses on defining the level descriptors for the position of the ATF in accordance with the EQF.

The project is funded by Erasmus + (KA2) with the participation of partners from Slovenia (SŠGT Maribor and INUK), Greece (OECON Greece), Austria (BEST), Portugal (SPI) and Cyprus (Nicosia Tourism Board and DekaPlus Business Services Ltd). The project will be completed by September 2022.
