HEADING TOWARDS THE END

The FAST consortium has finalised two out of the three intellectual outputs. During the last partnership meeting in Vienna, on February 22nd 2022, the partners endorsed these two deliverables.

"Job Description", the first intellectual output, details the Educational Qualifications, Experience, Personality Traits, Skills and Knowledge of the "Accessibility Travel Facilitator" (ATF). The consortium members first conducted interviews with tourism industry stakeholders which contributed to ATF's Job Analysis. Based on this, the Job Description and Job Specification of the ATF were developed.

The "Job Description" deliverable was sufficient to derive the "Qualification Descriptors", based on Level 5 of the European Qualification Framework. The descriptors help learners, education and training providers, and employers to position and value a specific qualification in relation to other qualifications. This definition will contribute to the objectives of promoting lifelong learning and will increase employability, openness to mobility and social inclusion of learners. It will also define the development of flexible and individualised pathways and the recognition of those learning outcomes acquired through non-formal and informal learning.

The two completed intellectual outcomes identified a set of learning needs for the ATF. In the final deliverable of the FAST project the partners will adopt the most suitable training methodology for the participant learners to achieve them. Furthermore, it will produced training plans, an assessment guide and the training material to support a FAST course.
