



### **FAST** project has reached its final stage

#### FAST training course - teaching, learning and professional toolkit

Under the O3 - Training Methodology and Didactic Materials - which aimed to formulate a training methodology to be used for the delivery of education, partners have designed methodologies, guidelines and a methodological framework for implementation. The consortium also defined a training curricula based on the learning needs identified in O2. Furthermore, an Assessment Guide was developed to assist the trainers on their assessment strategy throughout the learning process. As a final result, the teaching, learning and professional toolkit compiling all the materials will be made available for all interested parties.

#### Train the trainers event in Maribor, Slovenia

A Short-term joint staff training activity - the Train the Trainers event - was held between 21 and 23 June in Maribor, Slovenia. The event brought together trainers from the countries participating in the project: Slovenia, Cyprus, Greece, Austria and Portugal. The aim of this joint staff training activity was to test and validate the training methodology and materials developed by the consortium for the FAST training course and the teaching, learning and professional toolkit. The partners could collect feedback and relevant inputs and new ideas in order to optimise the final version of the developed toolkit.

#### **Multiplier events**

Partners are now organising the national multiplier events to disseminate the project results. The events will be used to further engage the target groups, stakeholders and the community.
